- Well written and readable, accessible to the general reader and not just to academics and researchers.
- Related to teaching and research on Islam and Muslim experiences globally.
- In addition to embedded hyperlinks, the authors may provide relevant audio and video material.
- Author(s) to provide a brief biographical description at the time of submissions.
